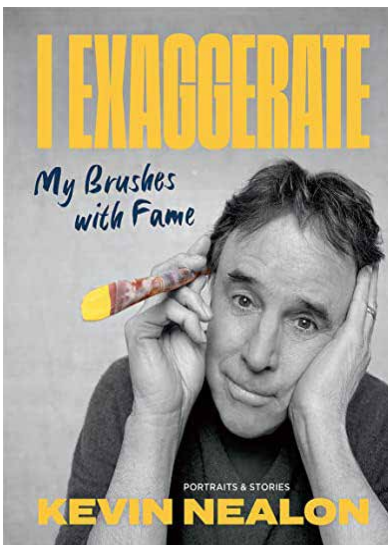
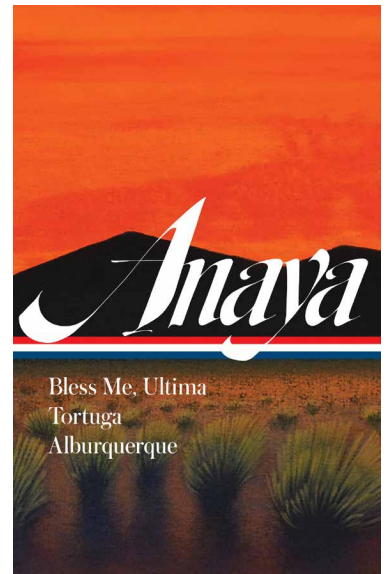


Anaya : Bless Me, Ultima; Tortuga; Alburquerque

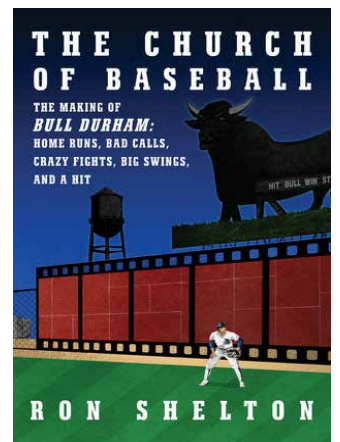


The Church of Baseball: The Making of Bull Durham: Home Runs, Bad Calls, Crazy Fights, Big Swings, and a Hit

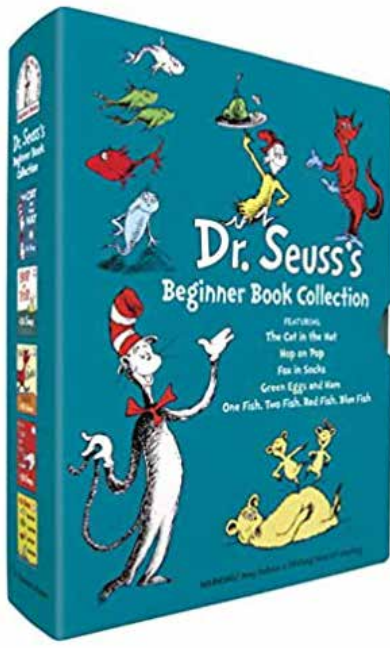

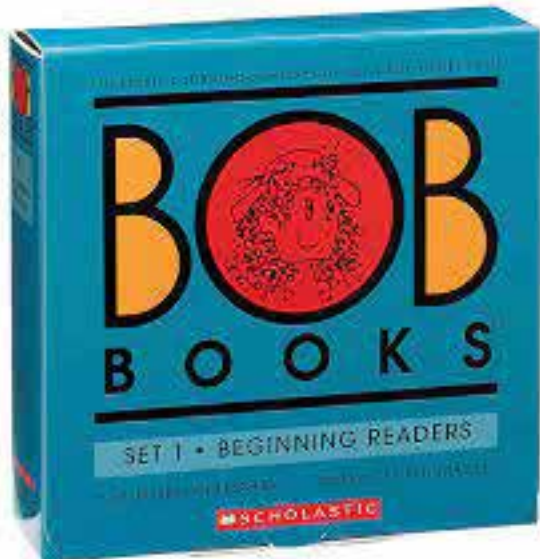

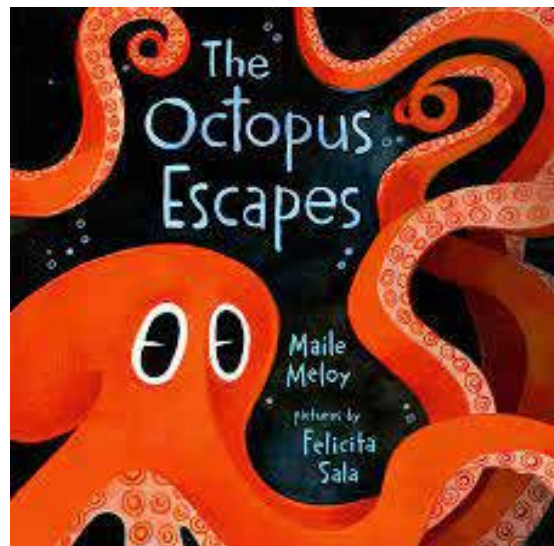


Bob Books for Beginning Readers

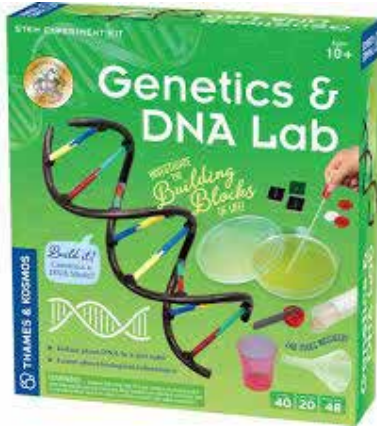
